

On Sunday, October 12 in the year 27 CE, Yeshua was celebrating the "Last Great Day" on the Temple Mount with his disciples. This event is commonly misinterpreted as the eighth day of Sukkot; really, it is a High Sabbath apart from Sukkot, immediately following the seven-day festival. To the casual pew-warmer, Yeshua's actions of that day may seem random and inconsequential. On the contrary; what he did had definite purpose with prophetic ramifications, as recorded in John 7:37-43:

"In the Last Great Day of the Feast, Yeshua stood up and cried out, "If any man thirst, let him come to me, and drink. He that believes on me, as the Scripture has said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water." (But this he spoke of the Spirit, which those who believe in him should receive, for the Ruach Kodesh was not yet given; because Yeshua was not yet glorified.) Many of the people who heard him speak said, "Truth, this is The Prophet." Others said, "This is the Messiah!" But some said, "Shall Messiah come out of Galilee? Has not the Scripture said that the Messiah comes from the seed of David, out of David's home town of Bethlehem?" So there was a division among the people."

So why all the ruckus? Why was there a division and why would Yeshua cry out like that? It was a perfectly calculated moment in time for Yeshua to reveal who he was through a well-known, first-century cultural event: the Water Libation ceremony. This ceremony, held annually on the Temple Mount on the Last Great Day (a.k.a. Shemini Atzeret) focuses on a prayer for rain. By his actions at this ceremony, Yeshua was prophetically proclaiming the future reality of the latter rain — or double portion outpouring of the Holy Spirit that will transpire during the future fulfillment of the Fall Feasts of YeHoVaH. This later outpouring will transpire as an intermediate fulfillment of the Fall Feast of YeHoVaH in which the 144,000 will participate.

Nothing in Scripture is random. Everything Yeshua did had purpose and significance. If you see something in the Bible you don't understand, search it out, for "it is the glory of YeHoVaH to conceal things and the glory of kings (that's you) to search things out."
